**** Around 6:55 PM, announce the net will start in five minutes.**

Good evening ladies and gentlemen. Does anyone need to use the WC4M (W4WEA) Repeater before I call the South Alabama Radio Club 2 meter net?

The purpose of this net is to pass information, bulletins and training in emergency radio communications and pass necessary weather information for the National Weather Service as part of SKYWARN operations. This net also maintains liaison with the Covington County Emergency Management Agency (EMA) as part of the RACES organization to support communications in the event of a natural disaster.

This net is held every Thursday evening at 7:00 PM on this primary frequency of 147.260 (146.640) and uses a secondary frequency of 147.260 (146.640) SIMPLEX as needed.

This is a directed net, do not transmit unless recognized by the NCS. Please pause between check-ins to avoid doubling. Any station not able to make the repeater, please come to 147.260 (146.640) simplex and request a relay.

Is there any emergency traffic? (if so, take care of the traffic).

Is there any formal or routine traffic? (if so, take care of the traffic).

Are there any mobile or short-time stations wishing to check in? (take callsigns and advise the operator he/she is free to secure at any time...AND thank them for checking in).

At this time, I will take general check-ins by prefix, starting with ALPHA prefixes...
